Qualifying landlords may receive up to \$29,000 for repairs needed to improve the health and safety of each self-contained rental housing unit, or those that share a kitchen and/or bathrooms also known as rooming-houses, through the Rental Housing Improvement Program and the Rooming House Assistance Program.
