Approach to Addressing Poverty

A group of leading anti-poverty, housing, and homelessness advocates today is calling on the federal government to adopt a rights-based approach in its forthcoming National Housing Strategy and Poverty Reduction Strategies. The call comes from the Canadian Housing and Renewal Association, the Canadian Alliance to End Homelessness, the Dignity for All campaign co-led by Canada Without Poverty and Citizens for Public Justice, and the United Nations Special Rapporteur on the Right to Housing, Leilani Farha.

The coalition has stated its support for designing the National Poverty Reduction and the National Housing Strategies (NHS) using a human rights framework. Regarding housing, the organizations are calling for complementary legislative and programmatic initiatives that would respect, protect, promote and fulfill the right to adequate housing as guaranteed in international human rights treaties committed to by Canada. This legislative amendment could be in the form of amending current housing-related legislation such as the National Housing Act, or creating new legislation.
