Non-Profit Housing Manager Exchange – April & May

Results of End of Operating Survey Session **April 5th from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm – Lunch included**

The Institute of Urban Studies, University of Winnipeg was contracted by MNPHA to undertake research on the End of Operating Agreements (EOA) in Manitoba. This was made possible from a grant from the Winnipeg Foundation and funding from Manitoba Housing. The ultimate goal of the project is to assist social housing providers in Manitoba plan and prepare for the end of their individual agreements, to strengthen each provider's capacity, and to increase their sustainability. The primary intended outcome is the development of a comprehensive 'training' program or tool that can be used to assist individual providers with the creation of individualized plans for EOA.

Results – Phase 1

The Institute sent out 203 surveys to housing providers in December and received 85 completed surveys, constituting a 42% response rate.
